Scientific data means the recorded factual material commonly accepted in the scientific community as of sufficient quality to validate and replicate research findings, regardless of whether the data are used to support scholarly publications. FIRST, SUBMIT A DATA MANAGEMENT AND SHARING PLAN (PLAN) WITH YOUR FUNDING APPLICATION; go to 3 (click on "Plan" for Complying with the NIH DMS required Plan content or see the NIH guidance about "Writing a Data Management & Sharing Plan") Plans must explain how scientific data will be managed and which scientific data and accompanying metadata will be shared. If due to legal, ethical or technical factors data preservation or sharing will be limited or restricted, these must be explained. Plans should be limited to 2 pages and follow content parameters. Plans will be reviewed by NIH program staff and—if a Plan is integral to a funding THEN ASK... opportunity announcement—by a study group. The JIT process will be used if needed to request revisions. Approved Plans will be added as an award Term and Condition. For NIH implementation details, visit their NOT-OD-22-198 announcement. What is required? SECOND, MAKE CERTAIN TO COMPLY WITH THE APPROVED PLAN Plans should, when necessary, be updated. Updates as well as compliance with Plans will be reviewed by NIH at regular reporting intervals or sooner. Non-compliance may be considered in continuing and future NIH funding decisions.
