When Performances of Everyday Life and Theatrical Performances Mix and Mingle

- The line between everyday life and theatrical performance is maleabable and porous. To investigate this I sought out amatuer performances at comedy and strip clubs and also made a month-long durational performance art piece called car.sick. that turned a 1994 Volvo into a roaming performance venue through the streets of Minneapolis.
- "amatuer" performers perform, their bodies are legible as untrained and give them away.

 Also, when art is taken out of it's bounded place spectators have to re-imagine how to interact with it.
