 is being pulled
 between the EU and
 Turkey for sphere of
 influence.
- Nearly 20 years after the cease-fire, Bosnia remains a state mired in externally imposed ineffective bureaucracy.
- The EU wishes to see
 Bosnian political
 and social systems
 progress to
 acceptable EU
 standards, but the
 current situation
 renders that
 impossible.

Significant connections are forming between Bosnian and Turkish political and religious figures, such that on the surface Bosnia, in many ways, looks like it is being reincorporated into metaphysical Neo-Ottoman space. Current Bosnian engagement with the EU has yet to go beyond moderator and moderated.
