Proposal Deadline: December 10, 2020
Award Amount: Up to \$20,000



EQUIPMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE ENHANCEMENT GRANT (EIEG)

Proposal Deadline: October 1, 2020 (Fall) /
March 11, 2021 (Spring)
Award Amount: Averages at \$40,000



FIRST YEAR ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (FYAP) GRANT

Proposal Deadline: October 22, 2020
Award Amount: Up to \$20,000



PLANNING GRANT (PG)

Proposal Deadline: October 1, 2020 (Fall) /
March 11, 2021 (Spring)
Award Amount: Up to \$25,000



MULTIDISCIPLINARY SUPPORT (MDS) GRANT

Proposal Deadline: November 19, 2020
Award Amount: Up to \$25,000



FUNDING AGENCY TRAVEL (FAT) GRANT

Proposal Deadline: None; ongoing
Award Amount: Up to \$1,000



SMALL GRANTS PROGRAM (SGP)

Proposal Deadline: October 8, 2020 (Fall) /
March 18, 2021 (Spring)
Award Amount: Up to \$3,000



THE FINE PRINT: FSU research faculty in full FTE, “active” status are eligible for CRC programs unless noted in the program RFP on the CRC website. All CRC programs require a detailed budget plan as part of the proposal submission. Information in this brochure is subject to change; see CRC website for official program announcements.

Honorary Recognition Programs

Nomination Deadline: January 28, 2021
Award Amount: \$10,000

DEVELOPING SCHOLAR AWARD (DSA)

Designed to identify, recognize, and honor future research leaders at the rank of Associate Professor.

DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH PROFESSOR (DRP)

Designed to recognize and honor outstanding research, scholarly, and/or creative activities among faculty with national and international visibility at the rank of full Professor.

DISTINGUISHED UNIVERSITY SCHOLAR (DUS)

Designed to recognize and honor outstanding research and/or creative activities among eligible specialized faculty at senior levels of their position.

DEVELOPING SPECIALIZED FACULTY (DSF)

Designed to recognize successful specialized faculty members several years into their careers and identify and honor future research/scholar/scientist leaders.

“One of these programs looks like a great fit for my research! Where do I go from here? How do I apply for one of these programs?”

Go to the CRC website at research.fsu.edu/crc and look for the **CRC Submissions Portal** link. The CRC Portal will allow you to electronically apply, submit, and request your Chair & Dean approvals all in one place.
